REMINDER

All Carriers Hauling Metal Coils in Alabama are REQUIRED to be certified by June 1, 2009!

Code of Ala.1975, 32-9A-4(d): Any motor carrier violating Section 32-9A-2(a) (4)a shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

Promulgated Rule No. 760-X-1-.16(2): In order to become certified in proper steel coil load securement, as required by <u>Code of Ala.1975</u>, 32-9A-2(a)(4) a, a commercial vehicle operator must:

- a. Complete the Securing Metal Coils Course that can be accessed through the website <u>www.metalcoiltraining.com</u> and take the exam this is part of that course;
- b. Obtain a copy of the certificate that notes successful completion of the course and that is generated by testing website upon passage of the exam;
- c. Sign the certificate and also have an official from the motor carrier for which he/she hauls or will haul metal coils sign the certificate;
- d. Retain the original copy of the fully signed certificate in the commercial vehicle when hauling metal coils; and
- e. Provide each and every motor carrier for which he/she hauls or will haul metal coils with a fully-signed copy of the certificate.
